## GRACE HOSPITAL

With the help of mission team who joined with our Haitian doctors and nurses good health was promoted with various vaccines, routine as well as life saving medical treatments for 5,099 patients, including children and widows living in our home facilities, along with walk-ins from the surrounding neighborhoods of Carrefour medical care was provided at our pediatric hospital and clinic.

At various times during the year six medical and dental mission teams from Florida hospitals came to minister assistance at our orphanages.

The Seventh Day Adventist Hospital was a great blessing to our Community. They also provided medical care to the orphan and school children, through the Sunshine Operation. Dr. Ava from Maryland continues to assist our hospital.



## SCHOOL CHILDREN EDUCATION:

Good education is the cornerstone of success in life of our children. 2000 students were educated, attending our elementary and high schools at our Waney and Lamentin campuses, and many of these students receiving full scholarships.

**HAITI HURRICANE RELIEF**

Responding to the dire situation of the Hurricane Matthew victims, in the south of Haiti; many of them taking night shelter in Caves in the hills above their destroyed homes, because of partners and supporters, we brought hundreds of emergency food and hygiene supply kits to help rescue over 300 families from the sea of sorrows they were experiencing.

We are also taking the following steps to further support the needs of these families by assisting with shelter and home repair/ home rebuilding, and medical assistance in the hardest hit areas. We are also assisting with farming assistance for reinstating food production. We have provided some water purification, as well as family empowerment to assisting with skill training and business development, and the Lord's Kitchen five (5) days per week feeding program.
